Fingal County Council Arts Office welcomes you to **Culture Night Fingal 2023** which returns on Friday 22nd of September. Culture Night, an annual national public event, celebrates culture, creativity and the arts. For one joyful night audiences can explore the rich arts and cultural events in Fingal, free of charge. Taking place across nineteen locations, the programme will feature live performances, an array of cultural activities and fun family friendly events. Fingal's finest heritage properties, art centres and cultural organisations will extend their opening hours to the public for an eclectic programme specifically designed for **Culture Night.**

Fingal Arts Office is delighted to present two special events for the programme. In celebration of the soon to be launched Skerries Art Trail, award winning illustrator and author Aoife Dooley will host 'Sketch Out' a fun drawing event exploring some of the sculptures featured in the trail. In collaboration with DDLETB and Music heritage, storytelling, talks and tours. Generation, musicians Cora Venus Lunny and Oliver Cole will perform live in Swords Sarah O'Neill as the town is set to become one of Fingal's music education hubs for children and young people.

Fingal Libraries will host an array of family friendly events at Malahide and Blanchardstown libraries and for those interested in exploring historic maps and local history there will be an opportunity to access the collection at the Fingal Local Studies and Archives.

Also taking part in Culture Night is The Séamus Ennis Arts Centre, who will host a special music event curated by Ronan Browne featuring up and coming pipers and younger visitors can enjoy a collage workshop with artist Karen Peakin. Ardgillan Castle's bespoke artists' studios and newly established art gallery will be open to the public and there will be an opportunity to meet the resident and exhibiting artists. Our Balbriggan will present live music performances at the Hub and St. Georges' Square.

Budding astronomers can explore DIAS Dunsink Observatory, the oldest astronomical observatory in Ireland. Visit Newbridge House, a beautiful Georgian property, for the screening of a period drama, take a tour of the magnificent medieval Malahide Castle or experience the iconic model railway collection at the Casino Model Railway Museum.

Join us for a night among the stars and expand your mind with cosmic insights from the astronomers of DIAS Dunsink Observatory! Dunsink is Ireland's oldest astronomical observatory and was once the home of one of Ireland's greatest mathematicians, Sir William Rowan Hamilton. Nowadays, DIAS astrophysicists study explosions on the Sun, search for new stars and planets, and search the universe for exotic astronomical objects. The programme includes a self-guided tour of the 18th century observatory and the Victorian engineering of the South Telescope built by Grubb of Dublin.

To celebrate Culture Night 2023, Fingal Local Studies and Archives will open their doors to the public. Visitors will be able to view many of the hidden gems which nestle within collections. their Hand-written minute of Dublin books County Council from 1898 along with those



of the Rural District Councils, Howth Urban District Council and the Balbriggan Town Commissioners will be on display. Letters written by those involved in the fight for Ireland's Independence can be read along with harrowing letters from the trenches of WW1. Survey maps of lands owned by the Hamiltons of Abbotstown and the Earl of Howth will be on view as well as a number of historic maps and a comprehensive local history collection. This is a rare opportunity for the public to go behind the scenes of Fingal Local Studies and Archives. Staff will be onsite to answer questions and guide visitors through the night.



STOCKINGS FOR THE QUEEN: A TALK BY BALBRIGGAN HERITAGE GROUP



Balbriggan, a small coastal town in North Fingal, was once a place with royal connections. From here, the word of fine Balbriggans (synonymous with underwear and hosiery of especially fine knitted fabric) spread around the world. Several renowned hosiery factories were established here, including the well-known Smyth & Co., whose high-quality hosiery won clients from the ranks of European aristocracy including the Empress of Austria, the Tsarina of Russia and the Princess of Denmark. Its most famous customer was, however, Queen Victoria of England who first commissioned stockings in 1837, the year of her coronation. Join David and Petra from the Balbriggan Heritage group for a fascinating talk and showcase of original artefacts of this once acclaimed local craft.


SKETCH OUT WITH AOIFE DOOLEY, SKERRIES
