Fingal County Council Arts Office welcomes you to Culture Night Fingal 2020. Culture Night is an annual all-island public event that celebrates culture, creativity and the arts. For one night only arts and cultural organisations, castles and historic houses in Fingal will extend their opening hours to the public, highlighting all the fantastic cultural facilities and talented people in the locality. Due to the recent challenges resulting from COVID-19, this year's programme combines free online digital and live events which will take place on Friday 18th September 2020.

Among those participating this year are recently opened venues in Balbriggan and Malahide. The Casino Model Railway Museum in Malahide which houses the iconic Fry Model Railway collection, in the beautiful newly restored Casino cottage will offer free self-guided tours and the Irish Institute of Music and Song, a superb new music facility in Balbriggan, will host tours of their historic buildings and pop-up music installations. There will be an opportunity to see a new mural in Balbriggan commemorating the Sack of Balbriggan which was commissioned by Fingal Arts Office in partnership with and on behalf of the Sack of Balbriggan Commemorations Committee. Fingal libraries will deliver an online festival consisting of different events which can be accessed through the Fingal Library YouTube channel and DIAS Dunsink Observatory will present a virtual night among the stars including online 'Light-speed' talks.

Join us for these events and more. Audiences of all ages can enjoy a variety of music, poetry, workshops, tours and talks specifically programmed for Culture Night in Fingal either online or at participating venues.



Join us for a virtual night among the stars. Expand your mind with great cosmic questions from the astronomers of DIAS Dunsink Observatory. Dunsink is Ireland's oldest astronomical observatory and was once the home of one of Ireland's greatest scientists, Sir William Rowan Hamilton. Nowadays, DIAS astrophysicists study explosions on the Sun, search for new stars and planets, and search the universe for exotic astronomical objects. Programme includes a virtual tour of the observatory, "light-speed" talks from leading astrophysicists and a questions & answers session, all from the comfort of your home. The interiors of Newbridge House are amongst the best preserved in Ireland. Fine examples of Irish craftsmanship can be seen throughout the house, the Cobbe Cabinet of Curiosities is a treat for all ages and, downstairs, the servant's quarters and historic Georgian kitchen allow visitors to imagine the hectic workload involved in running a house of this size (and witness the labour-saving devices of the past!).



SACK OF BALBRIGGAN MURAL - SUBSET

Well known artist collective Subset will have completed a special commission commemorating the Sack of Balbriggan and remembers 100 years since that historic event where the Black & Tans ransacked the town and killed innocent people. This new mural located on the gable wall of the Central Lounge on Bridge Street, while acknowledging this tragic moment in the town's history, celebrates its hopeful future. The mural was commissioned by Fingal Arts Office in close partnership with and on behalf of the Sack of Balbriggan Commemorations Committee whose input has ensured that the work reflects on the towns past and its bright future. The artists will commence the work from the 14th of September 2020. If you are passing Balbriggan's main street check out this new mural work on Bridge Street which will be completed on Culture Night!

THE IRISH INSTITUTE OF MUSIC AND SONG

CHURCH STREET, BALBRIGGAN, CO. DUBLIN

The Irish Institute of Music & Song will open its doors to the public for a mix of interactive musical performances, a heritage tour, and explorations of buildings old and new. Visitors are invited to tour the IIMS campus and enjoy pop-up musical installations in various locations, including performances from Ireland's National Barbershop Quartet Champions, Lady Barbalade, as well as musical ensembles from Africa, Irish traditional music, St Patrick's Brass and Reed Band, and performances by IIMS teachers. The tour includes Bedford House (historic Georgian House), The Square performance space, Dormitory Accommodation, Roscarrig House (historic Victorian House), the outdoor Amphitheatre, An Crann Ceoil (musical tree sculpture), and The Guitar Garden (unofficially the largest guitar in the world!).

Social distancing and appropriate health precautions will be in place to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for all visiting this new musical facility. All visitors are asked to wear a mask.
